- A \$25.00 service fee will be charged on all NSF cheques and credit card payments that are not approved.
- Band entries must be received at least 3 weeks prior to the contest date except for Maxville, entries must be received by June 9, 2014.
- Events may be withdrawn at the discretion of the PPBSO Board of Directors.
- Grade 5 Band band entries limited (Georgetown = 5)
- Georgetown, Cobourg & Cambridge Highland Games limited to 25 bands.
- Highlands of Durham Games limited to 20 bands.
- Kincardine Scottish Festival limited to 28 bands.
- Each pipe band *must* submit a roster of members with entry form. Juvenile bands must include Date of Birth on their roster.
- Each pipe band must register with the PPBSO office on the day of the games prior to or at 11:00 a.m.
- Each pipe band must provide someone to coordinate their prompt arrival on the contest field.
- All Bands are required to move through the final tuning area.

- For Grade 1 & 2, the choice of set or medley (if applicable) to be played will be determined by draw on the contest field, Maxville is Medley of choice.
- The names of tunes comprising all sets and medleys must be submitted with the entry form. For medley contests, bands are not required to begin their performance at the start line and may assume their final position before starting the contest.
- The duty band for the drum major contests will be drawn from all participating Grade 1 and 2 bands in rotation.
- All band ties are broken by ensemble. If a tie remains, it is broken by piping.
- Information on prize money, travel money and travel directions are available upon request from the PPBSO.
- It is the responsibility of competitors to be aware of all rules & regulations. Information on this form is not necessarily complete. Refer to PPBSO Rule Book or PPBSO website for specific information (<http://ppbsso.org/wp-content/uploads/2015/02/PPBSO-2015-Rulebook.pdf>), including Massed Band tunes, Bands authorize the Pipers' and Pipe Band Society of Ontario to broadcast, make video and audio recordings of competition performances. Such recordings from the North American Championships may be sold to the general public without payment of royalties to bands or individuals. Recordings from other contests may be freely distributed to other competing bands. As a condition of acceptance of this entry band members individually waive and relieve all claims.

Grade 1	2 Sets (2/4 march, strathspey and reel) 2 medleys - 5 to 8 minutes	8 pipers, 1 bass, 3 snare drummers and 2 tenors
Grade 2	2 Sets (2/4 march, strathspey and reel) 1 Medley - 4 to 7 minutes	6 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr. 2 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major only, in addition to the minimum of 6 other pipers, provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 2 bands may add a higher grade drummer as their lead drummer only, in addition to the minimum of 2 other snare drummers, provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 2 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer as their lead tenor drummer only, providing that he or she is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 3	1 Set (2/4 march, strathspey and reel) 1 Medley - 3 to 6 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.3 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major only, in addition to the minimum of 5 other pipers provided, he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 3 bands may add a higher grade drummer as their lead drummer only, in addition to the minimum of 2 other snare drummers, provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 3 pipe bands may add a higher-grade tenor drummer as their lead tenor drummer only, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 4	1 Medley - 3 to 5 minutes 1 Mini Set (MS) - Each mini set shall consist of 4 parts 2/4 march, 4 parts strathspey, and 4 parts dot/cut reel. All tune requirements may be satisfied by 1 4-parted tune, or 2 2-parted tunes. (refer to D-12.9)	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.4 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major or Pipe Sergeant only, in addition to the minimum of 5 pipers provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 4 bands may add a higher grade drummer as their lead drummer only, in addition to the minimum of 2 snare drummers provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 4 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer as their lead tenor drummer only, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 5	1 March Medley in Quick-time - 2:45 to 4:30 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.5 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major or Pipe Sergeant only, in addition to the minimum of 5 pipers provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 5 bands may add a higher grade drummer as their lead drummer only, in addition to the minimum of 2 snare drummers provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 5 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer as their lead tenor drummer only, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Juvenile	1 March Medley in Quick-time - 3:45 to 4:30 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers, whose 19 th birthday occurs after the contests being entered. DOB must be included with the Band Roster. Proof of age may be requested on the day of the contest. Pipe Major and lead drummer may be over 18 years of age.
